

RESOLUTION 2014-05
Designating Officials Registering Voters on Election Day

WHEREAS, the Town of Kewaskum, Washington County, Wisconsin wishes to comply with Wisconsin State Statute § 6.55(2)(c) which provides that the municipality may provide by resolution that voters go to a readily accessible location in the same building at the polling place to register; and

WHEREAS, the current polling place has space available to be set aside for registrations in the same area where the voting takes place that complies with Wisconsin State Statutes § 6.55; and

WHEREAS, the integrity of the election process is of utmost importance and will be maintained by this process,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Town Board of the Town of Kewaskum, Washington County, Wisconsin, does hereby resolve that the registration will be in the presence of the clerk, election inspector, or special registration deputy; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Registration and Voting locations will be clearly labeled by the Town Clerk.



The Town Clerk should properly post or publish this resolution as required under § 60.80, Wis. stats.




