

Ordinance No. 2018-02

Clerk/Treasurer Appointment

The Town Board of the Town of Kewaskum, Washington County, Wisconsin, ordains as follows:

That, pursuant to Wis. Stat. §60.30(1e) (a), the office of the Town Clerk and the office of the Town Treasurer shall be filled by appointment of a majority of the members-elect of the town board.

The term of office for the appointed positions shall be set by the town board, but may not exceed 3 years per §60.30(1e) (c). The town board may re-appoint the offices for additional terms. However, removal by the town board during a given term may only be for "cause" as defined under § 17.001 and required by §60.30(1e) (f).

This ordinance is subject to approval by the town electors in a referendum, which is hereby call by the Town Board to be held on April 2, 2019. The referendum questions shall be:

"Shall the person holding the office of Town Clerk be appointed by the town board?"

"Shall the person holding the office of Town Treasurer be appointed by the town board?"


The salary of the appointed positions shall be set by the town board and may not be reduced during the term of office.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its town board passage, notice after passage per § 60.80 and also its referendum approval by the town electors as required by §60.30(1e) (b).


