

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-02

Amending Chapter 17 of the Town of Kewaskum Code of Ordinances

WHEREAS, The Town of Kewaskum Plan Commission, by a majority vote of the entire Commission at a meeting held on April 15, 2019, recommended to the Town Board an amendment to change Chapter 17 – 17.13 Park District (P-1) to allow Mobile Food Establishments and Controlled Livestock Grazing as a Conditional Use.

WHEREAS, The Town of Kewaskum Town Board, by a majority vote at a meeting held on April 15, 2019, approved amending Chapter 17 – 17.13 Park District (P-1) to allow Mobile Food Establishments and Controlled Livestock Grazing as a Conditional Use.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Kewaskum, do ordain as follows:

Section 1: Amend Section 17.02 as follows:

- ❖ Create the following definitions and renumbering the section as required
 - **MOBILE FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS.** As defined in Wis. Stats. 97.30(1)(C), “A *movable vehicle, push cart, trailer, or boat which is periodically or continuously changes location including movable concession stands and similar temporary stations not operating from a permanent building licensed as a restaurant including those designed to operate as temporary food establishments or traveling retail food establishments as those termed in Wis. Admin. Code Chap. DHS196 “Appendix”.* Which are subject to state and jurisdictional inspection and license within every jurisdiction they operate in prior to opening as designated by the Plan Commission.
 - **CONTROLLED LIVESTOCK GRAZING.** An event of limited duration in which a site is to be used for grazing of livestock as designated by the Plan Commission.

Section 3: Amend Section 17.13 as follows:

- ❖ Create Section 17.13 (3) (A) Controlled Livestock Grazing
- ❖ Create Section 17.13 (3) (B) Mobile Food Establishments
- ❖ Renumber Section 17.13 as required

Section 4: Amend Section 17.17 as follows:

- ❖ Create Section 17.17 (6) Controlled Livestock Grazing
 - Controlled Livestock Grazing. The location, building and Site Plans and Plan of Operation shall be submitted for review/approval.
- ❖ Create Section 17.17 (10) Mobile Food Establishments
 - Mobile Food Establishments. The location, building and Site Plans and Plan of Operation shall be submitted for review/approval.
- ❖ Renumber Section 17.17 as required

Section 5:

This ordinance shall be effective May 20, 2019 upon passage and publication as required by law.
