

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-04

Amending Chapter 17 of the Town of Kewaskum Code of Ordinances

WHEREAS, The Town of Kewaskum Plan Commission desires to encourage agri-tourism, while maintaining the rural character of the township, thus by a majority vote of the Commission at a meeting held on September 19, 2020, recommended to the Town Board an amendment to Chapter 17. The amendment will add "Wedding Venue" as a Permitted Use under the Exclusive Agriculture (EA) Zoning.

WHEREAS, The Town of Kewaskum Town Board, by a majority vote at a meeting held on September 19, 2020, approved amending Chapter 17. The amendment will add "Wedding Venue" as a Permitted Use under the Exclusive Agriculture (EA) Zoning.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Kewaskum, do ordain as follows:

Section 1: Amend Section 17.03 as follows:

- Adding the following definitions and renumbering the section as required
 - WEDDING VENUE. A wedding venue is permitted in the EA Zoning District as a permitted use and shall be limited to wedding services and/or wedding receptions. No conditional use permit is required provided that the use complies with all of the following conditions.
 - Wedding Venue must follow all Building Code regulations as listed in Chapter 14.
 - No traffic related to the Wedding Venue may park on the township roads. Parking must be provided on said property.
 - Wedding Venue hours shall not extend past the hours of 9:00am and 11:00pm.
 - There shall be no more then 2 events a week and shall be between the months of May and October.
 - Wedding Venue must comply with Noise Ordinance as listed in Section 9.06.

Section 2:

- Create Section 17.07 (1)(V) Wedding Venue
- Renumbering Section 17.07 as required

Section 3:

This ordinance shall be effective September 19, 2020 upon passage and publication as required by law.
