**Town Board Meeting Minutes**

**Tuesday, July 27, 2021, 7:00 p.m.**

Town of Kewaskum Community Center • 9019 Kettle Moraine Drive • Kewaskum, Wisconsin

Present: Scott J. Wollner, Joe Herther, Holly Knoeck, Daniel Stoffel and Anne Trautner; Officer Trevor Kohn.

Chair Scott Wollner called the meeting of the Town Board to order at 7:00 p.m., followed by roll call and a reading of the Affidavit of Posting for the meeting. A moment of silence and the Pledge of Allegiance were observed.

Motion by Supervisor Knoeck, seconded by Supervisor Herther to approve the June 29, 2021, meeting minutes, voice vote, motion carried 3-0.

**Report by Deputy Trevor Kohn, Washington County Sheriff Department Liaison-**

**Discussion on accepting proposal by Washington County Executive Josh Schoemann's office on Washington County partnering with the Town of Kewaskum for the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Broadband Access Grant, which will provide approximately \$100 million in grants for Broadband Infrastructure Expansion-**  
No action taken.

**Discussion on proposal from Ethoplex on Ethoplex partnering with the Town of Kewaskum to use American Rescue Act (APRA) funding to improve broadband services in the town.**  
No action taken.

**Discussion on use of American Rescue Act (ARPA) funding.**  
Board discussed that taxes haven't increased in four or five years, so the town may be eligible to use funds for replaced revenue. No action taken.

**Cemetery Fees**

Discussion that other area cemeteries have higher fees for cemetery lots than the town does.  
Motion by Supervisor Herther, seconded by Supervisor Knoeck to increase cemetery lot fees to be: \$300 for a single lot for a town resident; \$500 for a double lot for a town resident; and \$900 for a single lot for a non-resident. Voice vote, motion carried 3-0.

**Road Report- Chairman Scott Wollner**

The town has finished mowing and is putting up signs. The town also did some shouldering work. Crack filling will be coming soon, in the next two or three weeks; should be done by September. Did some work by Badger Bridge, completion date of that is being pushed back one year. The state is absorbing the cost. The bridge may need to be downgraded to less than 20 tons.

The town got a new weed eater.

Salisbury Lane is ready for blacktop.

**Treasurer's Report- Treasurer Dan Stoffel**

The town is going to get quotes on flooring.

**Clerk's Report- Clerk Anne Trautner**

Getting closer to updating QuickBooks accounts to reflect this year's budget.

Would like to update the Zoning Maps- will contact Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission.
