**Town Board Meeting Minutes**  
**Tuesday, October 25, 2022**

Present: Scott J. Wollner, Joe Herther, Holly Knoeck, Dan Stoffel and Anne Trautner; and five concerned citizens.

Chair Scott Wollner called the town board meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., followed by a reading of the Affidavit of Posting for the meeting, the Pledge of Allegiance and roll call.

**Approval of Minutes from 9/27/22**

Motion by Supervisor Holly Knoeck, seconded by Supervisor Joe Herther, to approve the September 27, 2022, meeting minutes. Motion carried 3-0.

**Public Comments**

Gregg Williams, 2710 State Road 28, said he would like to lower the speed limit on State Road 28. He also asked if he could plant trees and put up a fence on his property. He was advised by the board that he could plant trees and put up a fence as long as it was on his property and not in the right of way.

Steve Sorensen, 3375 County Line Drive, said business is being conducted out of a neighboring property, where there is a lot of earthwork and noise.

**Report by Deputy Trevor Kohn, Washington County Sheriff Department Liaison**

No report; Deputy Kohn was absent.

**Road Report**

Chairman Scott Wollner reported that road work on South Mill Road has been completed. The town is waiting on some invoices and then can apply to be reimbursed through the Local Roads Improvement Program (LRIP).

Badger Road Bridge- On November 8, bids will be taken. Work can either start in January or in eight months from November 8. The bridge has been reduced to a 4-ton bridge. The state wanted to install electronic signage and stoplights, but now the county will handle it, so no electronic signs are needed.

The Town is renting a tractor with a big brush cutter for a week from Serwe. Snowplows are being prepped for winter.

Washington County will hold a workshop on horse ownership.


